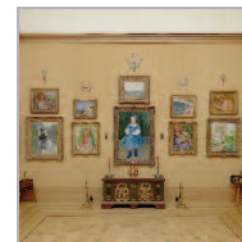
STOPS 4 & 18 Reading Terminal Market

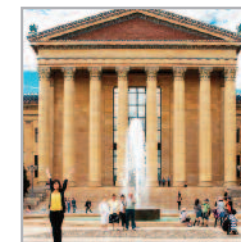
STOPS 7 & 15 The Franklin Institute

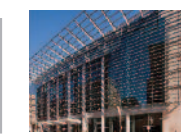
STOP 12 Please Touch Museum
